### Public Hearing of Desired Future Conditions

The Board will consider and/or take action on the following agenda items:

3. Proposed Desired Future Conditions:

The Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District is currently receiving public comments on the proposed desired future conditions for the area aquifers that were recently adopted by Groundwater Management Area 15 under §36.108, Texas Water Code. A hearing is set to consider and take action on the proposed desired future conditions for Colorado County as follows: between January 2000 and December 2069, an average drawdown of 17 ft for the Chicot and Evangeline Aquifers and 23 ft for the Jasper Aquifer.

The hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m. on June 22, 2017 at the CCGCD office located at 910 Milam St., Columbus, TX. Besides the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District (GCD), other Districts within Groundwater Management Area 15 include the following: Aransas County GCD, Bee GCD, Calhoun County GCD, Coastal Bend GCD, Coastal Plains GCD, Corpus Christi ASR Conservation District, Evergreen Underground Water Conservation District, Fayette County GCD, Goliad County GCD, Pecan Valley GCD, Refugio GCD, Texana GCD, and Victoria County GCD.

The public may submit written comments about the proposed desired future conditions to the District any time prior to the hearing. Comments may also be submitted at the scheduled hearing.

3. Adjourn Public Hearing

Citizens may comment for the record on items which are not on the agenda. The Board may not participate in discussion or deliberation of any item that is not on the agenda. Citizens may request that a topic be added to a future agenda. Citizens who wish to comment on a posted agenda item should sign a speaker's information card. Citizens may comment when the item is addressed by the board president. Citizens' comments are limited to three (3) minutes. The Board of Directors of the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by Texas Government Code Sections 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), 551.072 (Deliberations about Real Property), 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), 551.074 (Personnel Matters), 551.076 (Security Devices).
