

TRANSFER OF WELL OWNERSHIP

RULE 3.3.7 – PERMIT AMENDMENTS AND CHANGES

a) Change in Ownership – Operating permits are granted conditionally and are granted to a specific owner and type of water use. A permit may not be transferred by the holder. Provided that the new owner or operator maintains the same type of use of the well, makes no substantive changes to the well and fulfills any applicable requirements to the District, the General Manager may issue an operating permit without Board approval or need for public hearing for the duration of the original permit at a prorated application fee, if any.

Failure to provide written notice in the appropriate time frame will cause the permit to lapse and a new permit application will need to be submitted to the District for approval.
